

# Thinix Touch AppDock™ Exclusions

A user guide for configuring exclusions in the Thinix Touch AppDock™

This guide applies to Thinix Touch Version 6.4

# Overview

This guide demonstrates how to prevent icons from being displayed in the Thinix Touch AppDock™. Sometimes services expose themselves in the AppDock™ when a program is running as a service, or a program is running as a hidden process. For Thinix Touch to run seamlessly, these icons may need to be removed to avoid user confusion. This guide is based on installations of Thinix Touch 6.4 where the user has run the first time configuration for Thinix Touch.

## Thinix Touch 6.4 AppDock Exclusions

---

In certain situations there is a need remove running applications from being viewed in Thinix Touch.

- 1) Open the Themes Folder under the Thinix Touch folder (default folder is C:\Program Files\Thinix\Thinix Touch\Themes)
  - a. Open the theme you are working with (Gloss Black, navy Blue, etc.)
  - b. Open the EN folder
  - c. Find the dockexclusions.ini file and open the file in Notepad

Code Example:

- d. Save file and close Windows explorer.
- e. Open Thinix Touch and test the static button on the bottom of the screen
